Funding Allocation

- Same as First Round
 - Participation in NSLP/SBP 2022-2023
 - Base \$5,000
 - Plus allocated % based on enrollment (February 2020)
- Target SFAs: at least 25% of students certified for free and reduced priced meals

- Attestation Form
- Exemption Form for SFAs under 25% free and reduced

- Nile River: No action, will receive funding.
- Rock Mtns: No action unless circumstances have changed. Will need new attestation form to accept funding.
- Liberty City: Must submit Exemption Form first for review and approval.

Timeline

- October 2022
 - Award listing posted
 - Accepting new attestations and exemption forms
 - Ability to decline funding
- November 2022
 - Funds processed to CE
 - Continuing to accept new attestations and exemption forms
- December 2022
 - Funds processed to CE
 - No longer accepting attestations and exemption forms


