# Redistribution Process

Reconciliation should be completed by 2nd week in August

Excess will offset new allocations

Entitlement will be returned for any offset.

Assess ability to offer round 3 once completed

No state account pounds available



# School Year 2023 Entitlement and Orders

- ◇ Entitlement is currently negative 4 million dollars
  - ◇ Redistribution will provide free up some entitlement
- ◇ New Rate of Assistance = 43 cents
- ◇ 2023 DoD funds have been loaded in FFAVORS
- ◇ TX-UNPS has been updated to reflect orders.
- ◇ Round 3 ordering will be in August if entitlement levels allow.

# Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC)

- ◆ Finalizing purchases with USDA
- ◆ Allocating an additional \$1.6 million to DoD
  - ◆ Must delivered by September 30, 2022
- ◆ Allocations started
  - ◆ Bonus tab
