Summer P-EBT 2022

- **October 31- November 11:** Schools upload P-EBT eligible students to HHSC portal

- **P-EBT Eligibility:** Student must have been enrolled in the last month of SY 2021-22

AND

1. Eligible for free or reduced-price meals during SY 2021-22

- Between July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022

OR

2. Newly eligible for free or reduced-priced meals

- Between July 1, 2022 – August 29, 2022

- **Note:** Students with household applications received AFTER August 29 cannot be included in Summer 2022 P-EBT newly eligible upload

School Year 2022-2023 P-EBT

- Announced by USDA in September 2022
- Texas has not submitted a State Plan to USDA
 - Texas Health and Human Services, the Texas Education Agency, and the Texas Department of Agriculture working together to determine next steps
