

FOOD PACKAGES FOR HARVEYHOUSEHOLDS



The food packages are being made available through the Disaster Household Distribution program administered by the Texas Department of Agriculture in collaboration with Feeding Texas and the U.S. Department of Agriculture. All individuals in need of food as a result of the Hurricane Harvey disaster may pick up a food package from a food bank in a presidentially declared disaster county.

8th September 8th food packages will be available containing shelf-stable nutritious, high-quality foods--100 percent grown and produced on farms in the U.S.

PACKAGE CONTENTS 25 LBS.

Individuals and families impacted are eligible to receive one or more food packages with 10 to 20 food items that can be taken home and prepared as needed.

How and When?

Household Size	Food Package Count
1-3 family members	1 package per week
4-6 family members	2 packages per week
7+ family members	3 packages per week

Note: call the food bank before arriving to insure food is available.
