## Am I eligible for the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)?

A sponsoring contracting entity is a public or nonprofit private organization that is entirely responsible for the administration of the food program in the sites they sponsor.

If you are a for profit contracting entity and you own more than one site, you are considered a sponsoring contracting entity. However, you can only sponsor sites that are part of your legal entity (affiliated) and you cannot sponsor unaffiliated sites.

If you are a non profit contracting organization, than you can sponsor both affiliated and unaffiliated sites.
