Gentlemen:

As you know, Texas leads the nation in many things. Unfortunately, childhood food insecurity is one of them. However, our state is strategically utilizing federal resources to help alleviate hunger among Texas children during the summer months through the Summer Nutrition Programs (SNP). As required by SB 714 (73rd session), the enclosed report presents findings on school district participation in the SNP.

The Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) acquired these federally funded programs from the Texas Health and Human Services Commission in 2008. This report is the first to reflect the results of the programs entirely under TDA's administration. While the agency is still collecting claims, to date, the SNP have already set new records in 2010, serving 21 million meals and receiving \$52 million in federal reimbursements (13 percent more than 2009 and 24 percent more than 2008).

As Texas grows, so does the number of children who rely on the meals served through the SNP. To raise awareness of these critical summer feeding resources, I've enlisted the help of mayors all across Texas. Through an effort called the "Mayors Challenge," more sites are open past June to increase the number of meals served to hungry Texas children during the late summer months. It is critical the state and municipalities work together to leverage these federal funds so more Texas children have access to summer meals. It is also critical we use these programs to encourage overall healthy lifestyles and break the cycle of dependence in order to equip these children to become self-sufficient adults and parents.

I am proud of the work we have done to broaden the impact of these Summer Nutrition Programs. Continuing to increase participation in the programs is a priority for TDA. I hope that by providing this information, we will be able to help more school districts overcome challenges to providing nutritious summer meals for the children in their areas.

Participation in Summer Nutrition Programs

2009 and 2010

Executive Summary

The Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) is committed to increasing opportunities for children in Texas to receive the same nutritious meals in the summer as they do when school is in session. The Mayors Challenge, in which TDA challenges mayors to compete with each other to feed the highest number of children in their communities, has proven to be successful in increasing awareness of and participation in the SNP. Through innovative efforts such as this, TDA will continue to recruit partners to help end food insecurity in the Lone Star State.

Texas law mandates that public school districts with 60 percent or more of their students eligible to receive free or reduced-price meals in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) participate in the Summer Nutrition Programs (SNP) or request waiver from participation. In 2010, 407 school districts were identified as mandated, of which 73 percent offered an SNP. In 1997, there were 358 districts mandated to participate, of which 54 percent did so. In 2010, 97 percent of mandated districts complied with SB 714, which is up drastically from 1997, when only 80 percent provided an SNP or sought a waiver. The number disregarding the mandate has plunged by more than 80 percent – from 73 in 1997 to 14 in 2010.

While the number of districts seeking waivers from their obligation to participate in an SNP has risen, from 93 in 1997 to 95 in 2010, the overall percentage of mandated district waivers is down, from 26 to 23 percent. According to those requests, transportation cost is the single largest obstacle keeping school districts from participating, representing 34 percent of the waivers in 1997 and 53 percent in 2010.

There remain areas in the state where an SNP is not available. Although schools continue to be the focus of outreach efforts to increase the number of summer feeding sites in Texas, recruiting new sponsors from the private non-profit sector and governmental entities is equally important.

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1 **Charge**

2 In 1993, the 73rd Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 714, directing the agency administering
3 summer nutrition programs to submit biennial reports regarding participation in the programs.
4 Texas Human Resources Code, §33.024 under the heading SUMMER FOOD SERVICE
5 PROGRAM, reads as follows:

7 (j) Not later than November 1 of each even-numbered year, the department and the
8 agency shall provide to the Governor's Office of Budget and Planning, the Legislative
9 Budget Board, and the state auditor a report that includes a listing of school districts
10 identified as described in Subsection (c) that have become sponsors of a summer
11 program. The report must also include a listing of identified school districts that failed to
12 satisfy the requirements of this section. The report must also include the costs, above
13 federal funds, incurred by the school districts and the state in order to comply with this
14 section. The department shall notify members of the legislature and the standing
15 committees of the senate and house of representatives having primary jurisdiction over
16 the department of the filing of the report.

1 **Background**

2 Texas Senate Bill 714, enacted by the 73rd Legislature in May of 1993, amended Chapter 33 of
3 the Human Resources Code by adding Section §33.024, Summer Food Service Program (SFSP).
4 The amendment requires school districts with 60 percent or more of their children eligible for
5 free or reduced-price meals in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) to participate in the
6 SFSP by the summer of 1997. Mandatory participation is required only if federal funds are
7 available to cover the cost of operating the program. School districts can be granted waivers from
8 participation annually if certain conditions stipulated in the legislation are applicable.

9

10 Required participation was implemented incrementally by schools on an annual basis, beginning
11 in 1994 with schools having 90 percent of their children eligible and ending in 1997 with schools
12 having 60 percent of their children eligible. Public Law 108-265, the Federal Child Nutrition and
13 WIC Reauthorization Act of 2004, made a number of changes to the Child Nutrition Programs,
14 including provisions for a permanent summer feeding program through the NSLP as well as
15 simplifications to the existing SFSP. Together, the two programs are referred to as Summer
16 Nutrition Programs (SNP).

17

18 **Simplified Summer Food Service Program:** Public Law 108-265 also expanded provisions of
19 the 14-state pilot program of the simplified SFSP, which originated in 2001, to six additional
20 states with low participation rates and established permanent simplified cost accounting
21 procedures for all sponsors to include schools and non-profit organizations. The complex
22 reimbursement formulas were replaced with a straight “meals times rate” provision that allowed
23 maximum reimbursement regardless of actual cost. All SFSP sponsors continued to submit

1 budgets with their applications for participation but allowed experienced public and private
2 nonprofit schools an exemption from submitting a budget, if they participated in the SFSP
3 previously and had no operational problems.

4

5 **NSLP Seamless Summer Option:** The Child Nutrition and WIC Reauthorization Act of 2004
6 authorized a Seamless Summer Option through the NSLP as an alternative to the SFSP for
7 schools that already participate in school meal programs and wish to continue meal service into
8 the summer. The Seamless Summer Option operates according to the same procedures followed
9 during the school year except free reimbursable meals must be available for all children 18 years
10 and younger in the area. There is no cost accounting procedure required for public schools
11 electing to operate the Seamless Summer Option, other than those required for operating the
12 NSLP. When the Seamless Summer Option became available, schools that are required to offer
13 summer feeding were given the choice to participate in either the SFSP or Seamless Summer
14 Option to meet the requirement.

15

16 In 2007, the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) administered the Seamless Summer Option
17 while the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) administered the SFSP. As of
18 September 1, 2007, when the administration of both programs came under TDA's purview, TDA
19 became responsible for executing Senate Bill 714, managing the waiver process for mandated
20 participation schools and submitting biennial reports to the legislature in even-numbered years.

1 **Participation**

2 In 2009, a total of 380 school districts were subject to the requirements of Senate Bill 714 in
3 2009 with at least 60 percent of their students eligible for free or reduced meals. Of those 380
4 school districts, 266 participated in either the Summer Food Service Program or Seamless
5 Summer Option. In 2010, 407 school districts were mandated to offer a summer feeding program
6 or obtain a waiver from the requirement, of which 298 provided summer meals under one of the
7 programs.

8
9 Mandatory school districts are required to work with the state agency to remove barriers to
10 participation, locate alternate sponsors and process waiver requests. In both fiscal years 2009 and
11 2010, most mandatory school districts participated in the Simplified Summer Food Program, the
12 Seamless Summer Option or received a waiver to program participation, as the following tables
13 show. In 2009, 21 mandated districts neither participated nor obtained a waiver. In 2010, only 14
14 districts did not comply.

Waivers

School districts were granted waivers for the following reasons:

- Enrollment includes fewer than 100 children
- The cost of transportation is an insurmountable financial obstacle
- School buildings or cafeterias are under renovation or construction
- An alternate provider already sponsors an SNP in the area, or the state agency accepted that there were other extenuating circumstances

Attached are six appendices for fiscal years 2009 and 2010:

- Participants – lists of school districts mandated to participate in an SNP that either did participate or were granted a waiver for 2009 (Appendix A) and 2010 (Appendix D)

1 **Costs**

2 School districts that meet the 60 percent free and reduced eligibility threshold set forth in Senate
3 Bill 714 are asked to report to TDA the total cost of operating their summer nutrition program
4 once it has concluded. From those reported costs, TDA has deducted the amount of the federal
5 reimbursements made for that year's program to create the lists of costs, above federal funds,
6 incurred by the school districts and the state in order to comply with this section. Those district
7 costs are given in Appendix C (2009) and Appendix F (2010) for the districts that reported them.
8 TDA did not incur costs above federal funds to comply with Texas Senate Bill 714.
