Texas Local Food for Schools (LFS)

- *\$22.3 million* for Texas schools \bullet
 - Funded through the USDA Agricultural Marketing Service
 - Minimally or unprocessed foods served through NSLP •
 - Allowable costs: direct food costs, storage, and transportation
- Food items must be produced in Texas ullet
 - Intended to expand local and regional markets with an emphasis • on purchasing from historically underserved producers

Texas Local Food for Schools (LFS)

- LFS funds will be sub-granted to CEs
 - CEs will *opt into the program*
 - Awards will be made in the Fall 2023
 - Program funds must be expended by *March 2025*

Minimally and Unprocessed Foods

Examples of Allowable Products

- Fruits and vegetables, including 100% juices
- Grains pastas, rice
- Meats whole, pieces, ground meats
- Meat alternates beans or legumes •
- Fluid milk and dairy products yogurt, cheese
- Variety of processing states (whole, cut, pureed) and forms (fresh, frozen, dried, canned) ۲

Examples of Unallowable Products

Baked goods, prepackaged sandwiches/meals, chicken nuggets, fish sticks, pre-made • pizzas, etc.
