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WAYS TO JOIN A TEAMS MEETING

- **Join via the Web Browser**

- Click the meeting link
- Click “continue in browser”
- Give Teams access to your camera and microphone
- Enter your email and onetime passcode

- **Join via the Mobile App**

- Download the Microsoft Teams app
- Click the join button
- Give Teams access to your camera and microphone.



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HELPFUL TIPS

- Join 5–10 minutes early to test your audio and video settings.
- Use a supported browser such as Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome, or Safari.
- Ensure you have a reliable internet connection.
- Consider using headphones for improved audio quality.



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TROUBLESHOOTING

- Copy and paste the link directly into your browser.

- Clear your browser cache or use a private/incognito window.

- Confirm that your microphone and speakers are not muted.
- Verify that the correct audio and video devices are selected.

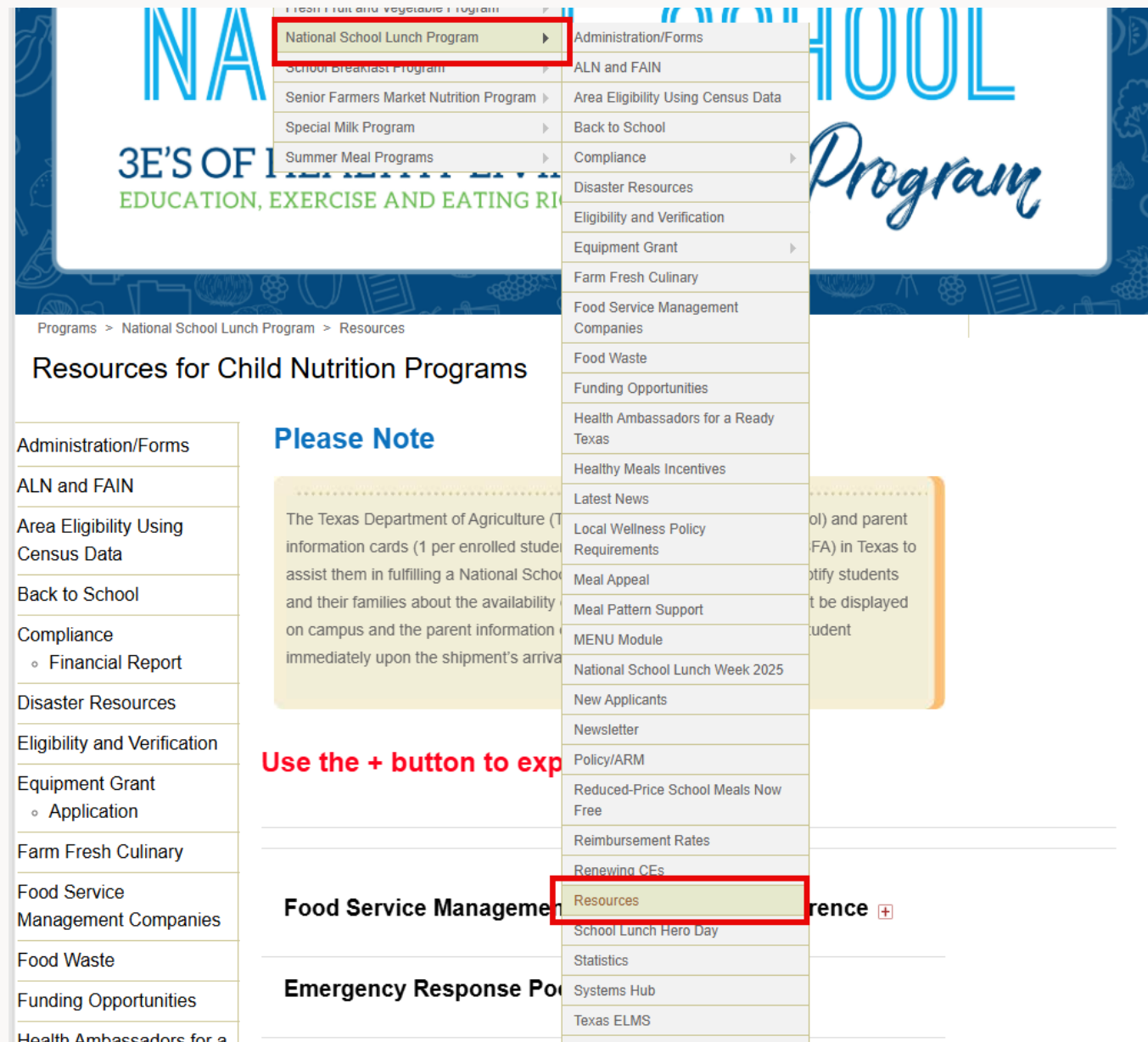
