





#### **Program Application**








#### How will basic applications, claims, etc. work in TANS?

#### Claims Dashboard





#### **Claims Detail**





### Will TANS be connected to PaySchools?

No, TANS will not be directly connected to any point-of-sales systems, including PaySchools.

TDA will continue to process payments in collaboration with the Texas Education Agency and our State Comptroller's Office. If you are not familiar with these entities, this is how reimbursements and payments are distributed right now.

# Will the Texas ELMS Direct Certification upload format change when SNP organizations begin using TANS?

No, Texas ELMS is a TDA-managed system, which stands alone from TX-UNPS and TANS. Texas ELMS will continue to accept uploads in the current format even after organizations switch over to TANS.

The only change users may notice is the login credentials used to access ELMS. Currently, Texas ELMS relies on TX-UNPS security roles. SNP users with the proper security role will have their ELMS security role migrated as they move over to TANS and will then begin using their TANS login credentials to access Texas ELMS.




