



#### Will FSMC representatives be granted access to TANS?

Yes, FSMC representatives can be granted view-only access to TANS. They will not have the ability to create, modify, submit, or take any other actions in the system.





#### Will my organization or site IDs change?

Organization IDs (formerly CE ID) will not change. Organizations active in TX-UNPS at the time of the transition will have their Organization ID migrated over, so they will see no change to their Organization ID.

For organizations that had no active profile in TX-UNPS at the time of the transition, new Organization IDs will be assigned. These new TANS Organization IDs will be 5-digit IDs beginning with a 1.

#### Will my organization or site IDs change?

Organization IDs (formerly CE ID) will not change. Organizations active in TX-UNPS at the time of the transition will have their Organization ID migrated over, so they will see no change to their Organization ID.

For organizations that had no active profile in TX-UNPS at the time of the transition, new Organization IDs will be assigned. These new TANS Organization IDs will be 5-digit IDs beginning with a 1.



# Will TDA migrate my organization's information from TX-UNPS to TANS?

#### TDA plans to migrate key foundational data:

- user credentials & security roles
- basic organization data organization name, id, region(s), EIN
- basic site data site name, site address
- data needed to complete calculations or track compliance
  - Severe Need Breakfast & Two-Cent Differential Lunch eligibility
  - CEP and Provision 2 eligibility and claiming rates
  - Area eligibility
  - Day Care Home Tier 1 eligibility
  - Serious deficiency tracking
  - Pre-approval site visit dates

Sponsors should be prepared to enter most data in the first program year. After the first year, most application data will rollover on application renewal.





# What documents and data does my organization need to be sure we have copies of outside of TX-UNPS?

To determine which documents or data must be maintained or saved for your organization to meet retention requirements, refer to the records retention guidance found in each respective program handbook.

Program handbooks are the most appropriate source for what types of documents need to be retained and for how long. The transition to a new system does not override record retention requirements.

As a part of these records retention requirements, organizations continue to be expected to retain copies of all necessary documents within their organization's local records. This means that the relevant files should be stored outside of TX-UNPS or any other TDA system. **TX-UNPS and TANS should not be your system for records retention.** 





#### How long will I be able to access my data in TX-UNPS?

All users will maintain access to TX-UNPS until the system is retired. Because NSLP, CACFP, and summer programs will complete program year 2026 in TX-UNPS, users can expect to retain access to the system at least through this period.

To help support a longer transition period, access will remain for users even if their organization is not participating in these programs.

TDA will be able to share a concrete end date for TX-UNPS access very soon. We understand this is a key piece of planning your organization's transition.
