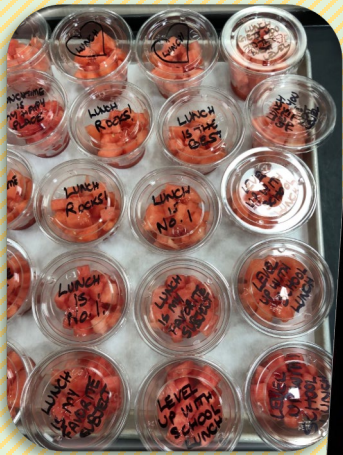




**Dickinson ISD** used their supply of "I Tried Local" stickers to entice students to choose side salads prepared with local cherry tomatoes
